



Signs of deterioration



Increasing respiratory rate, decreasing oxygen saturations or increasing need for supplementary oxygen are all indicators that the patient may be getting worse. This may mean the patient will require further help with breathing, such as intubation and mechanical ventilation. When observations are worsening, a doctor should be informed straight away.
